Ten years ago, On Ramp Resource Center was created to help 16-24 year olds who lack support to become independent. What began as a single room in the Children and Family Services Center has grown to a two-story building in Uptown Charlotte serving over 500 young people a year, maxing out the numbers we can serve in our current location. At last count, however, there were 45,500 disconnected young adults in Charlotte-Mecklenburg who aren't going to school or working. All those young adults need us!

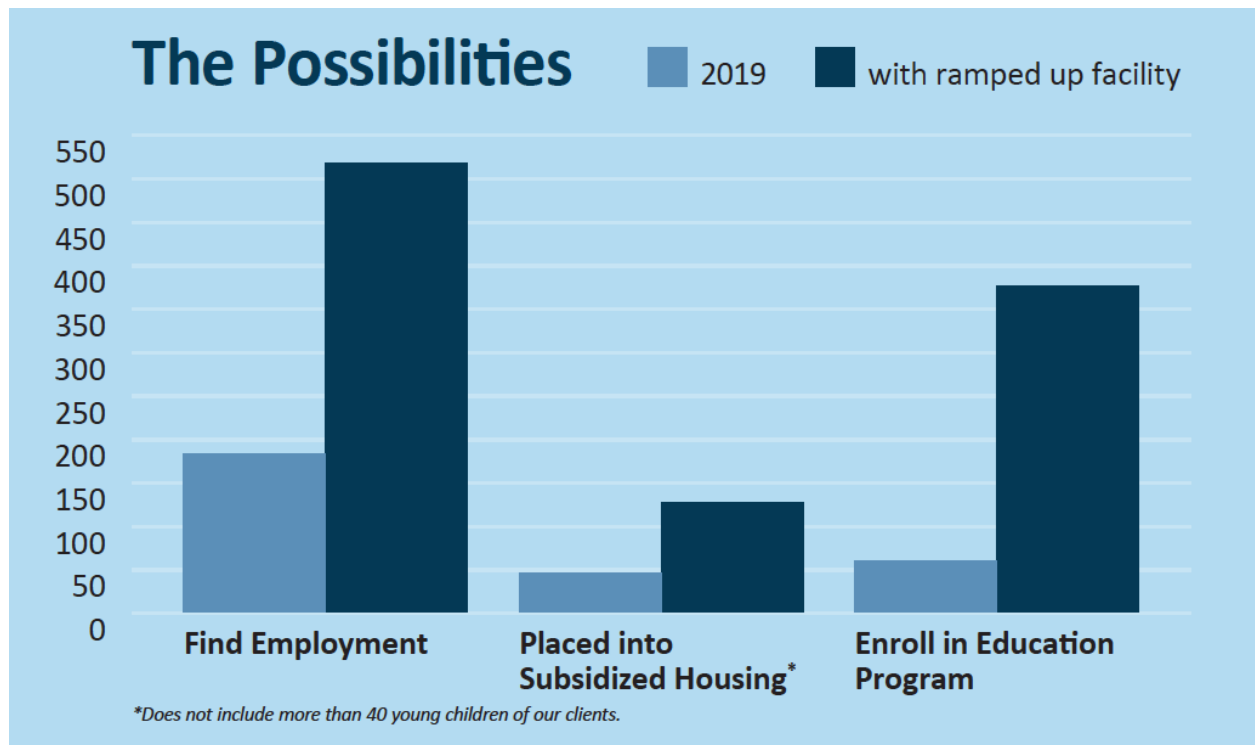
We are once again evolving to meet the need.

DREAMING A NEW VISION

We convened our young adults and staff to consider what additional support could be provided in a new site. Dreams for the young adults we serve include:

- Expanded in-take area and private interview spaces for confidential counseling and visiting professionals
- Dedicated classrooms for GED, tutoring and college prep
- A working and teaching kitchen to teach life skills and provide nutritious meals while promoting a healthy lifestyle
- Healthy activity space
- Art and music rooms to spark creativity
- Laundry and shower facilities
